

Application for accreditation as a SICOT Education Centre

The National Delegate will submit the application to the SICOT Head Office with the following documents:

1. Location of the proposed SICOT Education Centre ;
2. Attestation of belonging to a university or hospital ;
3. Approval of local university or hospital and Government authorities ;
4. Educational programme in orthopaedic surgery ;
5. Annual statistics of orthopaedic beds, admissions and operations ;
6. Availability of subspecialties of expertise in Orthopedics and Traumatology ;
7. Teaching facilities including space available ;
8. Teaching equipment, computers, internet, etc ;
9. Current activities: courses, lectures, surgical skills lab etc ;
10. Academic and consultant staff ;
11. Curriculum Vitae of proposed Director/ Coordinator of the Education Centre.

The application will be circulated to the Secretary General, First Vice President and Vice President of the geographical region concerned.

At least one of them or a member of the Executive Committee will visit the centre and report to the Executive Committee. This will be submitted with the recommendations to the International Council for approval.
